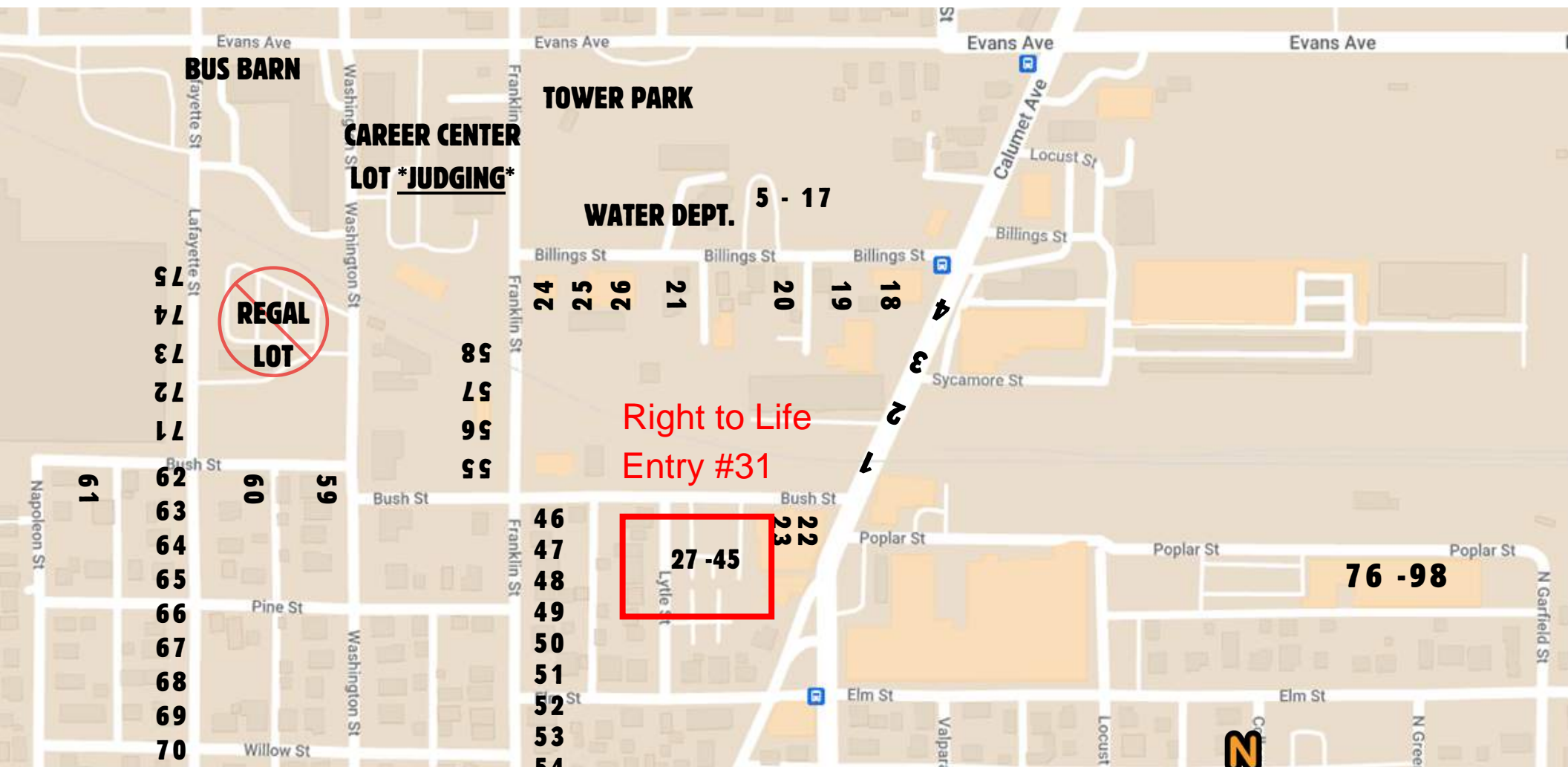

Parade 2024 Staging Directions
Please be in your designated area by 9:00 A.M.

#1-4 Park along Calumet at your numbered space north of the tracks. At 9:45, when the road is shut down, pull up to Elm Street and wait for the parade to begin. You may use both sides of the road here so as many units as possible are across the tracks. Please stay in number order when the parade begins.

#5-17 You will be parking in the lot at the Water Department. To get there, use Calumet to drive to Billings Street. Turn on Billings to the Water Department parking lot. You will park in the lot. At 9:45, you will drive to Calumet, turn south, and get in line with numbers 1-4.

#18-21 You will be parking on Billings Street. To get there, Use Evans to turn south on Franklin, then east on Billings. Your number will be on Billings Street near the Water Department.

#22 You will be parking next to the Old Town Banquet Center. To get there, use Evans to drive to Washington Street. Turn south on Washington. Turn east on Bush Street and park near the corner of Bush and Calumet, next to the Old Town Banquet Center.

#23 Unload vehicles at the animal clinic. Follow side driveway to Franklin, then to Bush Street as soon as possible in the morning. Park behind the Family Express truck along Bush Street next to the banquet center.

#24-26 You will be on Billings Street, along the grassy area next to Tower Park. To get there, take Calumet to Billings Street. Turn west and park on Billings along Tower Park, near the corner of Franklin and Billings. Park facing FRANKLIN. **At 9:45** turn left on Franklin and head to Bush Street. Turn left on Bush and line up behind the tractors near Old Town Banquet Center to wait. ***To avoid congestion, ask any parent dropping off a student to use Evans to drop off students at Tower Park. Students may then walk across the park to Billings.

#27-45 You will be lining up in the Old Town Banquet Center lot on Bush Street. **DO NOT** drive to the lot by way of Calumet, or tell others to drop off participants by way of Calumet. You may NOT enter Bush Street from Calumet. Bush Street will be an exit only. Also, the lot is ONLY FOR VEHICLES IN THE PARADE. To get to your staging area, take Evans to Washington Street. Drive south on Washington to Bush Street. Turn east on Bush and head to the parking lot.

#46-54 You will be parking on Franklin Street, and you will face Bush Street. To get to your space, follow Washington Street south to Walnut Street. Turn east on Walnut. Turn north on Franklin and find your number.

#55 Your unit will meet at Tower Park. At 9:45, follow Franklin to your number at the corner of Franklin and Bush. Stop there and wait. **STAY OUT OF THE STREETS WHILE WAITING. THE STREETS ARE NOT SHUT DOWN.**

#56-57 You will be on Franklin Street, just south of the railroad tracks. To get there, take Evans to Franklin. Turn south on Franklin, cross the tracks, and find your number just before Bush Street.

#58 You will park on Franklin, just north of the railroad tracks. To get there, take Evans to Franklin. Turn south on Franklin, and find your number just before the railroad tracks. The Valpo Schools and Pop Warner entry will be moving over the tracks at 9:45. When they are safely out of your way, move your unit across the tracks and wait by #56 & 57.

#59-60 You will be on Bush Street. To get there, take Evans to Lafayette Street. Turn south and follow Lafayette to Bush Street. Turn east on Bush and your number will be along the grassy area next to the Regal lot between Lafayette and Washington Street.

#61 Your area will be on Bush Street, just west of Lafayette St. To get there easily, follow Lafayette south to a block past Bush Street. Turn west and go to Napoleon St. Turn north and follow Napoleon to Bush. Your area is the whole space between Napoleon and Lafayette.

#62-70 You will be on Lafayette Street, facing Bush Street. To get there, follow Washington south to Walnut Street. Turn west on Walnut, then turn north on Lafayette and find your number.

#71-75 You will be on Lafayette Street, along the Regal parking lot. To get there, follow Evans to Lafayette. Turn south on Lafayette, cross the tracks, and find your number.

#76-97 You will be in the Direct Sales parking lot, which is behind Northsides. Do NOT try to enter here by way of Calumet. To get to your space, follow Roosevelt to Elm Street, which is near Beef Mart. Turn west on Elm. Follow Elm to Garfield. Turn north on Garfield. The road here looks more like a driveway as it winds around the Direct Sales building near the train tracks. Follow that road and find your number in the parking lot. The parking lot is **ONLY FOR VEHICLES IN THE PARADE.**
